Saluting The Cemetery's Caretakers

Through the years, many individuals have taken on the task of caring for the cemetery grounds. They have mowed the grass, filled, leveled and seeded new grave sites and in some instances trimmed trees and bushes.

The Memorial Society first employed a caretaker for the cemetery in 1923 when it hired Mr. Miller (his first name in not listed in Society records) at a monthly salary of \$35.00. The Society continued to employ and pay a cemetery caretaker until 2018 when the Society asked the City to assume the responsibility of routine cemetery care so it could concentrate on preservation and beautification projects. Since then, the mowing and care of new grave sites has been under the direction of Wright City officials.
